

Special Restricted Fund Scholarship

Application for 2010-11

The Wales-Fulkerson Educational Fund was established to grant scholarships for programs of undergraduate or graduate study granted by the Board, giving priority to students in graduate programs, to develop Presbyterian leadership through laymen majoring in natural and physical sciences, medicine, agriculture, business, law, or any other field related to these to be awarded to Presbyterian "qualified students" enrolled at one of the named universities.

Eligibility Requirements

Student must:

- Be an active member of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)
- Be a graduate or undergraduate student majoring in natural and physical sciences, medicine, agriculture, business, or law
- Be a full-time student at one of the following universities (in order of preference): University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign, University of Wisconsin – Madison, University of Indiana – Bloomington, University of Iowa – Iowa City, Ohio State University, University of Michigan – Ann Arbor, Michigan State University, University of Minnesota – Twin Cities, Northwestern University, Purdue University, or Washburn University
- Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale

- Biographical Questionnaire
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae
- 500 word essay on the assigned topic: What do you plan to study, and what are your plans for your education and/or career after college?
- Pastor Endorsement/Church Membership Form
- Official Transcript (through Spring 2010)
- Financial Information Form

Our Process

The Office of Financial Aid for Studies has remaining funding for up to two awards of \$2500 each. These awards will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis to eligible students with complete applications. Application materials do not have to be submitted in one packet, but your application will not be evaluated until all materials have been received.

We handle most applicant communication, including awarding notices via email to the address listed on your application. If you prefer to be contacted via mail, please note that on your application.

Applications will be awarded as funds remain, but the absolute deadline for application is October 1 (postmark).

Resume/Curriculum Vitae

Prepare and attach a one page resume or C.V. detailing activities you have participated in during your college years. When preparing your resume, consider how you have participated in the life of your college or university, church, and community.

- Provide dates of participation
- Note the frequency (daily, weekly, monthly, etc) of activities that occur over a span of time
- Summarize your involvement in the activity

Don't forget to include any awards you have received in these activities.

If you have had a job, you may wish to include that as well. Please provide an estimate of the number of hours worked weekly.

Essay

Prepare an essay of at least 500 (no more than 1000) words on the assigned topic. Your essay must be typed and double-spaced. Students may prepare their essay in the language of instruction at the institution they attend.

Topic: What do you plan to study, and what are your plans for your education and/or career after college?

Administrative Notes

Email & Faxes

Some elements of your application may be submitted by fax or email. These elements include only: <u>Essay</u>, <u>Resume</u>, and <u>Church Membership Form/Endorsement</u>. Biographical Questionnaires must be mailed to the address shown on page one of the application packet. Emailed submissions will receive an acknowledgement email within 48 business hours of submission. *If you do not receive an email acknowledgement regarding your email submission, it has not been received by our office and the paperwork should be mailed.*

Confidentiality of Evaluations

Information collected to support your application is maintained by the Office of Financial Aid for Studies. The church membership/endorsement form and work product of the staff and reading committee are confidential and will not be released to the student. Only staff members with responsibility for the HRF program and the HRF reading committee members view applications.
