Spanish Language School for Lay Leadership at

Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary

Purpose: Develop a *Spanish Language School for Lay Leadership* through Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary which is user-friendly and contextualized to the Hispanic/Latino reality in the mid-western/south synods and presbyteries where there is no such program at present.

*Co-Sponsors/Partners: Louisville Presbyterian Theological Seminary; GAMC Hispanic/Latino/a Congregational Support Office; GAMC Office of Resources and Relationships with Hispanic/Latino Constituencies; Hispanic/Latino/a Commission of Mid-Kentucky Presbytery; Synods and Presbyteries in the south and mid-western states: (Partner MGBs so far: Synod of Lincoln Trails, Mid-Kentucky Presbytery and Charleston-Atlantic Presbytery)

• Criteria for Admission and Receipt of Seminary Diploma

- Students from presbyteries in partnership with the school that are recommended by their congregation, NCD, or fellowship, based on gifts for church leadership. Criteria for admission are not based on educational achievement or documented status.
- CLP students must be recommended by their presbytery.
- o Individual consideration will be given to students of other Christian denominations.
- Student must complete the entire course of studies to receive a diploma from LPTS.
- Individual courses can be taken by persons wishing to further their theological training or to fulfill presbytery requirements as in the case of immigrant pastors and leaders.
- o This is a life-long learning program and carries no academic credit.

 - Approximate cost of the program per course: \$1150 per course total (10 students, 1 professor)
 - Cost to student from partner presbytery per course: \$25 per course plus books/materials, meals and transportation to LPTS
 - Cost to student from non partner presbytery or another denomination per course: \$100 plus books/materials, meals and transportation (housing included).
