



The two items mentioned as the subject of this email are linked by the Lake Institute on Faith and Giving of the School of Philanthropy at Indiana University. The General Assembly Mission Council is partnering with the Lake Institute and interested presbyteries to provide training and support for congregations to Create Congregational Cultures of Generosity. What about congregations under water? In the most recent newsletter from the Lake Institute, Dr. William Enright considers what congregations should do when they are "under water," meaning they are spending 20 to 30 percent of their annual budget in debt reduction. He says these congregations are caught in an austerity crisis and are "unable to think beyond survival, let alone dream about a tomorrow." What should they do?

Dr. Enright says they should:

- 1. Focus on **enhancing the services** they provide for their members and the surrounding community;
- 2. Strengthen their annual fundraising program by **utilizing best fundraising practices**;
- 3. Build a major gifts program working with people of vision and generosity to **create special giving opportunities** that will give birth to new programs, breathe life into old bones, and resuscitate hope!
