Third Baptist Church will host our first worship service since March in the sanctuary on

<u>Wednesday, July 8th at 6pm</u>. The staff and Leadership Ministry Team have been working diligently to organize and prepare for what we pray is a meaningful time of worship. A date to resume our Sunday service has yet to be determined, and we will continue to worship together by radio broadcast and on Facebook at 10:45 am.

Corporate Worship is a special time to join in a spirit of victory, praise, and celebration. Because of our commitment to the safety of every valued member of our family, our service will be unique to prior experiences. We ask for your cooperation.

If you are at a higher risk for severe illness per CDC guidelines; have had fever, or signs of illness (coughing, shortness of breath, sneezing, etc.) or have had close contact with a person who has symptoms or been diagnosed with Covid-19, we ask that you remain at home. The worship service will be broadcasted live on our Facebook page.

Our goal is to come together for worship and bible study in the safest way possible and ask that each of you adhere to the guidelines listed below.

Park in the north parking lot and enter the building on Allen Street.

Masks are required and will be available if you need one.

Maintain a physical distance of six feet between families.

Ushers will seat you once you enter the facility.

Restrooms are closed and only available for emergency use.

Bring your own Bible; the pews will be emptied of all materials.

Childcare Center will not be available. Children must remain with their parents.
