


CONFESSION OF SINS

THE WORD

FIRST LESSON 1 Kings 22:10-28

Dressed in their royal robes, the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat king of Judah were sitting on their thrones at the threshing floor by the entrance of the gate of Samaria, with all the prophets prophesying before them. Now Zedekiah son of Kenaanah had made iron horns and he declared, "This is what the LORD says: 'With these you will gore the Arameans until they are destroyed." All the other prophets were prophesying the same thing. "Attack Ramoth Gilead and be victorious," they said, "for the LORD will give it into the king's hand." The messenger who had gone to summon Micaiah said to him, "Look, as one man the other prophets are predicting success for the king. Let your word agree with theirs, and speak favorably." But Micaiah said, "As surely as the LORD lives, I can tell him only what the LORD tells me." When he arrived, the king asked him, "Micaiah, shall we go to war against Ramoth Gilead, or shall I refrain?" "Attack and be victorious," he answered, "for the LORD will give it into the king's hand." The king said to him, "How many times must I make you swear to tell me nothing but the truth in the name of the LORD?" Then Micaiah answered, "I saw all Israel scattered on the hills like sheep without a shepherd, and the LORD said, 'These people have no master. Let each one go home in peace." The king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, "Didn't I tell you that he never

prophesies anything good about me, but only bad?" Micaiah continued, "Therefore hear the word of the LORD: I saw the LORD sitting on his throne with all the host of heaven standing around him on his right and on his left. And the LORD said, 'Who will entice Ahab into attacking Ramoth Gilead and going to his death there?' One suggested this, and another that. Finally, a spirit came forward, stood before the LORD and said, 'I will entice him.' 'By what means?' the LORD asked. 'I will go out and be a lying spirit in the mouths of all his prophets,' he said. 'You will succeed in enticing him,' said the LORD. 'Go and do it.' So now the LORD has put a lying spirit in the mouths of all these prophets of yours. The LORD has decreed disaster for you." Then Zedekiah son of Kenaanah went up and slapped Micaiah in the face. "Which way did the spirit from the LORD go when he went from me to speak to you?" he asked. Micaiah replied, "You will find out on the day you go to hide in an inner room." The king of Israel then ordered, "Take Micaiah and send him back to Amon the ruler of the city and to Joash the king's son and say, 'This is what the king says: Put this fellow in prison and give him nothing but bread and water until I return safely." Micaiah declared, "If you ever return safely, the LORD has not spoken through me." Then he added, "Mark my words, all you people!"



SECOND LESSON 2 Peter 1:20-2:3

Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. But there were also false prophets among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you. They will secretly introduce destructive heresies, even denying the

sovereign Lord who bought them—bringing swift destruction on themselves. Many will follow their shameful ways and will bring the way of truth into disrepute. In their greed these teachers will exploit you with stories they have made up. Their condemnation has long been hanging over them, and their destruction has not been sleeping.


VERSE OF THE DAY

GOSPEL Matthew 7:15-29

"Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them. Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles?' Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!' Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash." When Jesus had finished saying these things, the crowds were amazed at his teaching, because he taught as one who had authority, and not as their teachers of the law.

There will be a special Voters' Meeting following the 10:00 AM service today to approve the following motion.

Motion:

In accordance with Section 107 of the Internal Revenue Code, Grace Lutheran Church of Tucson, AZ designates \$15,000 of Pastor Colin Rieke's compensation for housing allowance, including utilities, for 2011.

As a reminder, this is simply a tax designation which is voted on for each pastor each year. It is important to do this before Pastor Rieke begins serving at Grace.

Pastor Koehler re-elected to serve as Circuit Pastor

At a June 4 circuit meeting of pastors, male teachers, and lay delegates from the Tucson congregations, Pastor Koehler was re-elected to serve as Circuit Pastor for the Saguaro Circuit, which is comprised of the five Tucson congregations. This is a two-year term. Here is a brief description of the position: The circuit pastor serves as the "pastors' pastor." He visits the pastors and congregations of the circuit to discuss the goals and work of the synod and to assist in solving problems. He has oversight of doctrine and practice in the circuit, conducts call meetings for congregations (for calling pastors). He serves as the right hand of the district president in the area and serves on the district council. The Handbook for Circuit Pastors includes sections on Confidentiality, Encouragement, Good Listening, Helpfulness, and Promoting a Spirit of Unity. The circuit pastor's gifts ought to include these things. He conducts regular meetings (study, business, fellowship) of the pastors on the circuit.

Arizona Tuition Tax Credit

Students from Grace have received almost \$21,000 in tuition assistance through the Arizona Tuition Tax Credit program. These scholarships are available from donations made to the HELP Scholarship Foundation, the Institute for Better Education, and other School Tuition Organizations. Donations of up to \$500 per person or \$1000 for married couples may be claimed as a tax credit. Thank you to many members and friends of Grace who have contributed through this program. Donation forms are available in the Fellowship Hall if you would like to contribute. Please speak to one of the pastors if you would like more information.

ALA Scrip

Purchase full-value gift cards through the Arizona Lutheran Academy Scrip program and a portion of your purchase is used in support of Lutheran education. Gift cards are available from a wide variety of retailers, from grocery stores and restaurants to home improvement and electronics stores. Using Scrip is another way you can support Lutheran education without even spending additional money (just use Scrip for purchases you are making anyway)!

From June 1, 2010 through April 24, customers at Grace have purchased over \$120,000 worth of Scrip gift cards. This has resulted in over \$6,000 of profits. About half of all profits benefit ALA directly, and the other half may be directed by the customers (to ALA, to Grace, or to the tuition account of a student at ALA or Redeemer—see the sign in the courtyard display case for eligible students from Grace).

If you are a qualifying Scrip customer, you will receive a profit report with the opportunity to direct your Scrip profits as you choose. Scrip profits that are directed to Grace will be used for our 100th Anniversary celebration and Vail Outreach.
