



#### THE WORD

FIRST LESSON Exodus 32:15-29

Moses turned and went down the mountain with the two tablets of the Testimony in his hands. They were inscribed on both sides, front and back. The tablets were the work of God; the writing was the writing of God, engraved on the tablets. When Joshua heard the noise of the people shouting, he said to Moses, "There is the sound of war in the camp." Moses replied: "It is not the sound of victory, it is not the sound of defeat; it is the sound of singing that I hear." When Moses approached the camp and saw the calf and the dancing, his anger burned and he threw the tablets out of his hands, breaking them to pieces at the foot of the mountain. And he took the calf they had made and burned it in the fire; then he ground it to powder, scattered it on the water and made the Israelites drink it. He said to Aaron, "What did these people do to you, that you led them into such great sin?" "Do not be angry, my lord," Aaron answered. "You know how prone these people are to evil. They said to me, 'Make us gods who will go

before us. As for this fellow Moses who brought us up out of Egypt, we don't know what has happened to him.' So I told them, 'Whoever has any gold jewelry, take it off.' Then they gave me the gold, and I threw it into the fire, and out came this calf!" Moses saw that the people were running wild and that Aaron had let them get out of control and so become a laughingstock to their enemies. So he stood at the entrance to the camp and said, "Whoever is for the LORD, come to me." And all the Levites rallied to him. Then he said to them, "This is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: 'Each man strap a sword to his side. Go back and forth through the camp from one end to the other, each killing his brother and friend and neighbor." The Levites did as Moses commanded, and that day about three thousand of the people died. Then Moses said, "You have been set apart to the LORD today, for you were against your own sons and brothers, and he has blessed you this day."





Pastor Koehler has received a Divine Call to serve as President of Michigan Lutheran Seminary in Saginaw, Michigan. MLS is one of two WELS preparatory schools (along with Luther Prep School in Watertown, WI). The school's mission is to prepare young people for a lifetime of service to the Lord Jesus Christ. The special purpose of MLS is to train high school students for the public ministry of the gospel and to enroll them upon graduation at Martin Luther College, New Ulm, Minnesota.

This means that Pastor Koehler now holds two calls—one to Grace and one to Michigan Lutheran Seminary. He asks that you please keep him and his family in your prayers as he considers whether to continue to serve the Lord here at Grace or to accept the Call to serve as president of MLS. He invites any thoughts or questions you might have regarding this Call.

### **Arizona Tuition Tax Credit**

Students from Grace have received almost \$21,000 in tuition assistance through the Arizona Tuition Tax Credit program. These scholarships are available from donations made to the HELP Scholarship Foundation, the Institute for Better Education, and other School Tuition Organizations. Donations of up to \$500 per person or \$1000 for married couples may be claimed as a tax credit. Thank you to many members and friends of Grace who have contributed through this program. Donation forms are available in the Fellowship Hall if you would like to contribute. Please speak to one of the pastors if you would like more information.

### **ALA Scrip**

Purchase full-value gift cards through the Arizona Lutheran Academy Scrip program and a portion of your purchase is used in support of Lutheran education. Gift cards are available from a wide variety of retailers, from grocery stores and restaurants to home improvement and electronics stores. Using Scrip is another way you can support Lutheran education without even spending additional money (just use Scrip for purchases you are making anyway)!

From June, 2010 through May, 2011, customers at Grace purchased \$134,622.09 worth of Scrip gift cards. This has resulted in \$7,177.07 of profits. About half of all profits benefit ALA directly, and the other half may be directed by the customers (to ALA, to Grace, or to the tuition account of a student at ALA or Redeemer—see the sign in the courtyard display case for eligible students from Grace).

If you are a qualifying Scrip customer, you should have received a profit report with the opportunity to direct your Scrip profits as you choose. Scrip profits that are directed to Grace will be used for our 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration and Vail Outreach.
