

AUGSBURG CONFESSION & A MIGHTY FORTRESS

INVOCATION

MINISTER: It is with one accord taught and held, following the decree of the Council of Nicea, that there is one divine essence which is named God and truly is God.

CONGREGATION: But there are three persons in the same one essence, equally powerful, equally eternal: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

M: All three are one divine essence, eternal, undivided, unending, of immeasurable power, wisdom, and goodness,

C: The creator and preserver of all visible and invisible things.

CONFESSION OF SIN

- **M:** It is taught among us that since the fall of Adam, all human beings who are born in the natural way are conceived and born in sin.
- C: This means that from birth they are full of evil lust and inclination and cannot by nature possess true fear of God and true faith in God.
- **M:** Moreover, this same innate disease and original sin is truly sin.
- C: And condemns to God's eternal wrath all who are not in turn born anew through baptism and the Holy Spirit.

ALL: With might of ours can naught be done,
Soon were our loss effected;
But for us fights the valiant one,
Whom God himself elected.
You ask, "Who is this?"
Jesus Christ it is.
The almighty Lord.
And there's no other God;
He holds the field forever.

THE GOSPEL

- **M:** It is taught that God the Son became a human being, born of the pure Virgin Mary,
- C: And that two natures, the divine and the human, are so inseparably united in one person that there is one Christ.
- **M:** He is true God and true human being who truly was born, suffered, was crucified, died, and was buried
- C: In order both to be a sacrifice not only for original sin but also for all others' sins and to satisfy God's wrath.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF FORGIVENESS AND ENCOURAGEMENT FOR LIVING

- **M:** It is taught that we cannot obtain forgiveness of sin and righteousness before God through our merit, work or satisfactions,
- C: But that we receive forgiveness of sin and become righteous before God out of grace for Christ's sake through faith.
- **M:** To obtain such faith God instituted the ministry of teaching the gospel and administering the sacraments.
- C: Through these, as through means, he gives the Holy Spirit who produces faith where and when he wills.
- M: It is also taught that such faith should yield good fruit and good works,
- C: And that a person must do such good works as God has commanded.

ALL: The Word they still shall let remain
Nor any thanks have for it;
He's by our side upon the plain
With his good gifts and Spirit.
And do what they will—
Hate, steal, hurt, or kill—
Though all may be gone,
Our victory is won;

FIRST LESSON 2 Kings 23:1-3

Then the king called together all the elders of Judah and Jerusalem. SECOND LESSON Ephesians 2:1-9

As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. All of us also lived among them at one time, gratifying the cravings of our sinful nature and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature objects of wrath. - C: Forgive us for Jesus' sake, O Lord.
- **M:** We earnestly implore you, O Lord, to increase our loyalty and love for you. Constantly reform and purify your church. In this day of spreading error and confusion, grant all Christians the blessing of true faithfulness to your Word. Use us to bring its saving truths to many and grant that, thereby, many will come to follow in the way of life everlasting.
- C: Hear us, O Lord, for the glory of Your Name!

LORD'S PRAYER AND ADMONITION

- **M:** Friends in Christ: I invite you to lift up your hearts to God and pray with me the Lord's Prayer as Christ our Lord taught us.
- C: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name...
- **M:** Here we pray that God our Father in heaven would look with mercy on all his children on earth. We ask him to give us grace that we might proclaim his Word faithfully and live our lives according to his will, for then we show that his name is precious to us. We also pray that he would keep us from any teaching and living which would dishonor his name.
- C: Thy kingdom come...
- **M:** We pray that his Kingdom and the rule of his grace might come to us and grow in us each day; that all who are still captives in Satan's kingdom might be brought to know Jesus Christ, his Son, so that the Christian Church might grow and prosper.
- C: Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven...
- **M:** We pray that the Holy Spirit would strengthen us to do and accept God's will, in life and death, in good times and in bad, and that we might have power to put down our own sinful will and its desires.
- C: Give us this day our daily bread...
- **M:** We pray that our Father would also give us our daily bread, preserve us from greed and selfish desires, and help us to trust that he will provide for all our needs.
- C: Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us...

- **M:** We ask that God would forgive our sins as we forgive those who sin against us so that our hearts may rest and rejoice in a good conscience before him, and that no sin may ever frighten or alarm us.
- C: And lead us not into temptation...
- **M:** We pray here that God would protect us from all temptations and help us by his Spirit to put down our sinful flesh, to despise the world and its vices and to overcome the devil and all his trickery.
- C: But deliver us from evil...
- **M:** And finally, we pray that God would deliver us from all evils of body and soul, now and forever.
- C: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.
- **M:** All those who sincerely desire these things will say from their hearts, Amen, trusting without any doubt that their prayers are answered in heaven, as Christ has promised: "Whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours."

BENEDICTION

- **M:** The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God the Father, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.
- C: Amen, Amen, Amen. (Sung)
