FIRST LESSON Daniel 6:10-12, 16-23 (NIV)

Now when Daniel learned that the decree had been published, he went home to his upstairs room where the windows opened toward Jerusalem. Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God, just as he had done before. Then these men went as a group and found Daniel praying and asking God for help. - C: All this God does only because he is my good and merciful Father in heaven, and not because I have earned or deserved it. For all this I ought to thank and praise, to serve and obey him.
- M: And I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from all eternity, and also true man, born of the virgin Mary, is my Lord.
- C: He has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil, not with gold or silver but with his holy, precious blood and with his innocent suffering and death.
- M: All this he did that I should be his own and live under him in his kingdom,
- C: and serve him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness, just as he has risen from death and lives and rules eternally.
- M: And I believe that I cannot by my own thinking or choosing believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to him.
- C: But the Holy Spirit has called me by the gospel, enlightened me with his gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith.
- M: In the same way he calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith.
- C: In this Christian church he daily and fully forgives all sins to me and all believers.
- M: On the Last Day he will raise me and all the dead and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ.
- C: This is most certainly true.
