
Hymns are found in our hymnal, *Christian Worship*, which is the red book in the pew rack in front of you.



FIRST LESSON

"I will make a covenant of peace with them and rid the land of wild beasts so that they may live in the desert and sleep in the forests in safety. I will bless them and the places surrounding my hill. I will send down showers in season; there will be showers of blessing. The trees of the field will yield their fruit and the ground will yield its crops; the people will be secure in their land. They will know that I am the LORD, when I break the bars of their yoke and rescue them from the hands of those who enslaved them. They will no longer be

plundered by the nations, nor will wild animals devour them. They will live in safety, and no one will make them afraid. SECOND LESSON

After this I looked and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and in front of the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands. And they cried out in a loud voice: "Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb." All the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They fell down on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, saying: "Amen! Praise and glory and wisdom and thanks and honor and power and strength be to our God for ever and ever. Amen!" Then one of the elders

asked me, "These in white robes-who are they, and where did they come from?" I answered, "Sir, you know." Solomon's Colonnade Solomon's Colonnade was a 75 feet by 45 feet portico—a roof supported by columns—which the Jewish historian Josephus said was the only remaining portion of the temple built by Solomon, which was destroyed by the Babylonian king Nebuchadnezzar in 586 B.C. Jewish rabbis and Jesus taught there and Christians used to meet there after Jesus' ascension (Acts 5:12).

Then came the Feast of Dedication at Jerusalem. It was winter, and Jesus was in the temple area walking in Solomon's Colonnade. The Jews gathered around him, saying, "How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Christ, tell us plainly." Jesus answered, "I did tell you, but you do not believe. The miracles I do in my Father's name speak for me, but

you do not believe because you are not my sheep. My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand. I and the Father are one."


