
Hymns are found in our hymnal, *Christian Worship*, which is the red book in the pew rack in front of you.



#### OH, TASTE AND SEE



The banner in front of church features several major themes from our Summer Worship Series. It also includes a Luther's Seal, a visual representation of the theology that he learned from the Bible. The parts of the seal include a black cross that represents Christ's death for our sins inside a red heart representing faith that holds to Christ and brings spiritual life. The white rose signifies joy, comfort, and peace. The sky-blue field signifies the beginning of heavenly joy, as does the gold ring which indicates that this joy is eternal.

#### SECOND LESSON

Dear friends, do not be surprised at the painful trial you are suffering, as though something strange were happening to you. But rejoice that you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed. If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. If you suffer, it should not be as a murderer or thief or any other kind of criminal, or even as a meddler. However, if you suffer as a

1 Peter 4:12-19 (NIV)

Christian, do not be ashamed, but praise God that you bear that name. For it is time for judgment to begin with the family of God; and if it begins with us, what will the outcome be for those who do not obey the gospel of God? And, "If it is hard for the righteous to be saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?" So then, those who suffer according to God's will should commit themselves to their faithful Creator and continue to do good.

He then began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and after three days rise again. He spoke plainly about this, and Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. But when Jesus turned and looked at his disciples, he rebuked Peter. "Get behind me, Satan!" he said. "You do not have in mind the things of God, but the things of men." Then he called the crowd to him along with his disciples and said:

"If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me and for the gospel will save it. What good is it for a man to gain the whole world, yet forfeit his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels."

# **Special Voters' Meeting Result**

An August 20<sup>th</sup> meeting was held to decide whether to move forward with the purchase of land for Grace-Sahuarita and plans for a new church building along with a Child Learning Center. In a brief, 22-minute meeting, the voters unanimously decided to proceed with the project and to engage Kingdom Workers as consultants for this land purchase and building project. We thank all those who participated in the three Member Feedback Meetings held this summer and all those who offered their thoughts and prayers during this time. We ask the Lord of the Church to bless our efforts as we go forward!

Our next step as a congregation will be to accumulate down payment funds for the land. We estimate the needed amount to be \$75,000. Grace has a specific fund for this project called the Grace-Sahuarita New Building Fund. You may begin giving to this fund immediately through the Grace website or by designating your gift for this fund through offering envelopes.
