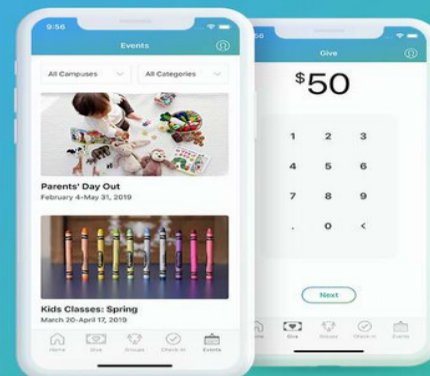

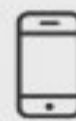

## TUNES THAT TEACH: PEACE BE STILL Mark 4:35-41

Storms (both physical and spiritual) often prove to be \_\_\_\_\_. Mary Ann Baker wrote the \_\_\_\_\_ for a hymn which reveals the \_\_\_\_\_ and constant \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus in life’s storms.

The Sea of Galilee is a \_\_\_\_\_ in Israel, subject to frequent \_\_\_\_\_. One fell upon Jesus and the apostles, who panicked, so Jesus used this to teach. The hymn “Peace be Still” describes:

- The Crisis – They were surprised because all were obeying Jesus’ \_\_\_\_\_. They were surprised because Jesus appeared to be \_\_\_\_\_. When God seems \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ He is drawing us to \_\_\_\_\_. He promises His presence, not a \_\_\_\_\_. Be still and wait upon God. (Isaiah 50:10)

- The servant like the Master will face storms.
