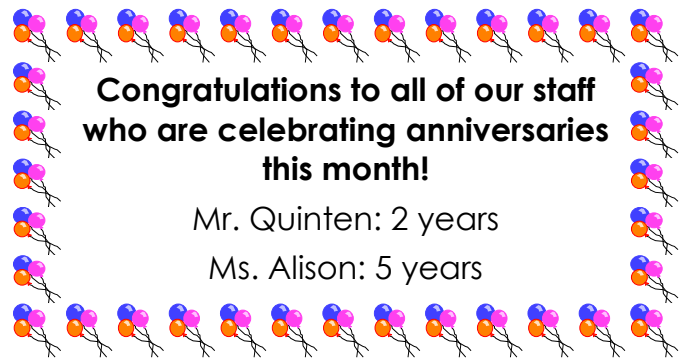
Breakfast!
