As we approach Easter, I want to make you aware of some special services that are upcoming.

On April 2nd, we are blessed to have Eli Birnbaum lead a service called "Christ in the Passover." Eli is a Jewish believer, serving as a missionary with Jews for Jesus in Israel. His presentation shows the link between the ancient Festival of Redemption and Christ as the Lamb of God. This sermonic demonstration is visual, so you will actually see a table set with traditional Passover items. The missionary uses Scripture as well as the visual items to walk through a Jewish Passover Seder, weaving the story of the Exodus together with the life, death and resurrection of Christ. The words He spoke in the upper room come alive as each Hebraic item is carefully explained. We will finish this powerful presentation by celebrating communion.

The Priscilla Shirer Simulcast will be that following Saturday, and I encourage women of all ages to be a part of this worship, prayer and sound Biblical teaching event from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. This is the second

year we have hosted this simulcast and women from surrounding communities (Lenox, Osceola and Winterset) are driving those distances just to participate with us. Don't miss it! You can still sign up online.

On Palm Sunday, our choir will be sharing a message of Jesus' love demonstrated through the Cross. These songs will be a familiar blend of hymns and worship songs with which you'll want to sing along.

Our service times will change a bit for Easter with an early service at 7:30 a.m., followed by breakfast (sign up to bring breakfast food at the Welcome Center). Sunday School will be at 9:30 a.m. and worship at 10:45 a.m.

While every Sunday is a great time to invite friends and family to church, the Easter season is a time during which more people are inclined to go to church. So, be bold and ask someone to join you for these special services as we celebrate the risen Christ.
