Beloved.

I remember attending a very popular church when I first went to seminary. The preaching was excellent and young families and seminary students flocked to it. The church was recommended by friends who had preceded us to Fort Worth. There were many things that appealed to us, but one thing caused us to continue our pursuit of a church family elsewhere. We arrived one Sunday morning with our 10-month old little girl and there was no one in the nursery to receive her. We waited and finally, an apologetic woman appeared, and we went on to our Sunday School class...late.

That same morning as we sat in the pew during the service, we heard an announcement that volunteers were needed immediately to care for the children in the nursery. I know the church was probably having growing pains. but we did not return. A standard that we held against any church was the level of care they gave children. That meant having clean facilities and workers who were ready and eager to receive and teach the children entrusted to their care for an hour. We thought it so important that I ultimately


