In April, our Church Council met to discuss a number of items that impact the short-term and long-term ministry of Crest. Many of you know that David Livingston, our collegiate director, will be leaving at the end of May to continue his education and help in the collegiate ministry at Simpson College. We are sad to see him go but grateful that God has laid a good foundation on David's ministry among the students at SWCC.

As David leaves, we are prayerfully considering the next steps for what will be called "The Light Company." The name change signifies a collaboration of collegiate ministries, including Simpson and Grinnell and potentially other smaller college and community college ministries. We look forward to this connection to help us engage students in conferences, retreats and mission trips with students from other colleges.

Additionally, our Church Council will be considering expanding our leadership base, instituting security measures for our children's ministry and developing a timeline and the priorities for adding vocational ministers. While I have no plans for an imminent retirement, we would do well to consider what a transition might look like and add staff with that in mind so that there is an uninterrupted ministry at Crest when that time

comes for the Spindlers to transition out of vocational ministry. So, don't be surprised or worry if you receive a call or survey from our Church Council in the next year as we seek God's discernment in these matters.

I want to thank the wonderful team of volunteers that helped Crest host the Priscilla Shirer Simulcast in April. We had a number of churches from the region represented, and the attenders all gave a great review of the event and our hospitality. Thanks to Teresa Pendegraft, Jennifer Hoyt, Patty Marean, Dorine Peterson and so many others who planned, promoted and served so many guests to our church. We hope that this will just be the beginning of additional women's events!

Let me encourage you to support two upcoming fund-raising meals. The Cancer Support Ministry will be hosting a fried chicken and fixn's lunch after church on May 1. The proceeds from this free-will offering meal will help this ministry support cancer patients through the challenges they face. Then, on May 25, we will host a benefit supper for Bobby Hiatt, a kindergarten-age Team-KID participant, facing surgery for Chiari Malformation. Thank you for being such a caring church!
