ADULT BIBLE CLASSES ON SUNDAYS

SUNDAY (9:00 A.M.)

The Church God Desires — No church is perfect, but the church can be ever striving to become more like Jesus, the head of the church. It's important, then, for the church to evaluate its ministry, mission and witness. Jesus delivered messages to seven different churches in the Book of Revelation, and His messages provide an ideal way for us to evaluate how the church is doing-and how we, as individual members of His church are doing.

Elijah: Living Outside the Comfort Zone (Beginning July 25) We don't go looking for difficulties, but there are moments when we need to willingly step into something challenging. The Old Testament prophet Elijah modeled for us both how to rely on God regardless of the challenges and mistakes we can avoid. (Bible Studies for Life— Room 109/Joe Powers and Fellowship Hall/Jamie Travis)

Chasing God—Based on Angie Smith's book, this seven-week study considers how many Christians' lives are stacked up with a "required" pile of false obligations and bloated assumptions. So many requirements, so many rules and so much guilt where there is supposed to be freedom is why many feel they never measure up and that they are failures as a Christian. Instead of chasing God, it's a matter of following...the difference of looking for Him and looking at Him. When We Say Father— (Beginning July 18) Based on the Lord's Prayer, this sevensession study by Adrian Rogers takes the model prayer and breaks it down to its most basic components.
