Beloved.

We had some wonderful news to share with the congregation at our meeting in February which bears repeating. In 2009, Crest secured a 15-year, \$693,000 loan to begin construction on our educational building. We were aided by a \$300,000 grant from the DEKKO Foundation due to our relationship with Mayflower Heritage Christian School.

At the time of this loan, we were still paying off a \$450,000 loan on the Worship Center that was incurred in 2005. Many of you entered into a five-year pledge, giving sacrificially toward the educational building construction. In 2014, we retired the Worship Center loan after nine years, two months of its inception.

In 2015, the debt reduction was added to our budget, though many continued to maintain their 5-year pledges. With their help and the Finance Committee having the leeway to aggressively attack this debt, we were able to retire the loan after 7 years and eight months. "We're debt free!" That is a big PRAISE THE LORD!

When I was interviewed by the Search Committee in 1994, they

asked if I would be willing to lead the church in a building campaign. I said that I was more interested in building people, but if necessary, we would build facilities. While it was a challenge to go through two building programs in five years, God saw us through them!

However, we know that "brick and mortar" do not make a church ...the people do. We are described as the body of Christ, who is the head of the church (Colossians 1:18). And over the years, God has blessed us with many who have associated with this church. While I am grateful for the tool that a facility is for ministry, the building is never the end but the means to the end, by which we are allowed to gather, stimulating "one another to love and good deeds ... encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near" (Hebrews 10:24-25). So, thanks be to God for His provisions and to you for the stewardship that has allowed us to minister to so many through our facilities and beyond as the church is built up.

ADDITIONAL CLASSES


