Beloved.

I want to give you some updates on where we are and what we hope to see in the near future. As we have shared previously, some of our hesitation in reopening elements of our ministry has been the lack of available sani-

tizing equipment and products. That still is an issue in local retail outlets, as well as commercial suppliers. After months of waiting, we do have hand sanitizing stations and an electrostatic spraver just arrived. The botanical, non-toxic disinfectant that we will be using kills 99.9% of bacteria, viruses, fungi and molds. Beyond our need to address COVID-19 concerns, these steps will be helpful for future preventative actions during the regular cold and flu seasons.

That said, we are still limiting our in-person worship services and classes. The current configuration of our worship center would accommodate no more than one hundred without overflow seating in the foyer or fellowship hall. Therefore, we will continue to offer two service opportunities on Thursday evening and Sunday morning for the foreseeable fu-
