A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTORS

"Why do we fast, but you do not see? Why humble ourselves, but you do not notice?" Look, you serve your own interest on your fast day, and oppress all your workers. Look, you fast only to guarrel and to fight and to strike with a wicked fist. Such fasting as you do today will not make your voice heard on high. Is such the fast that I choose, a day to humble oneself? Is it to bow down the head like a bulrush, and to lie in sackcloth and ashes? Will you call this a fast, a day acceptable to the LORD? Is not this the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of injustice, to undo the thongs of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and to break every yoke? Is it not to share your bread with the hungry, and bring the homeless poor into your house; when you see the naked, to cover them, and not to hide yourself from your own kin? Isaiah 58:3-7

What can you say about the fact that a text about fasting is the lesson for the day on Super Bowl Sunday, one of the biggest junk food days on the American calendar?! We also will celebrate communion on that day. Delicious ironies all around!

Here's a little history of Souper Bowl Sunday, adapted from their webpage.

In 1990, Brad Smith, then a seminary intern serving at Spring Valley Presbyterian Church in Columbia, SC, prayed a simple prayer: "Lord, even as we enjoy the Super Bowl football game, help us be mindful of those who are without a bowl of soup to eat" and an inspiring a youth-led movement to help hungry and hurting people around the world was born.

Why not use Super Bowl weekend, a time when people come together for football and fun, to also unify the nation for a higher good: collecting dollars and canned food for the needy? Youth could collect donations at their schools and churches in soup pots, and then send every dollar DIRECTLY to a local charity of THEIR choice.

Since 1990 ordinary young people have generated an extraordinary \$70 million for soup kitchens, food banks and other charities in communities across the country. In addition, hundreds of thousands of youth have experienced for themselves the joy and satisfaction of giving and serving, inspiring people of all ages to follow their generous example.

Our Youth are partnering with Brenham HEB to serve hungry families in our community. Please support their efforts with a donation of cans and/or cash.


Every man in the church will want to attend to learn about the effect on county taxes the state legislature may have. He promises to have upto-the-hour information to share. Dinner will be provided.
