A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTORS

Through this church season bracketed by the Epiphany and Ash Wednesday we listen each week to Jesus' teachings on the law and on love. Matthew 5-7 (the Sermon on the Mount) challenges the way the Pharisees had replaced a covenant written on the heart and not in stone (Jeremiah31:31) with legalism and ritual observance.

At first glance, it seems that Jesus is making it even harder to follow the rules. Yet the teachings in these chapters of Matthew's Gospel are not meant to create more external laws - more rules to be followed in order to be 'right' with God - these chapters seem to be pointing to something even more important than a command to follow the letter of the law. They seem to point to how we are to love God and love our neighbor.

It's not enough, Jesus says, to avoid murder; we also have to treat each other with respect because getting angry and yelling demeans and diminishes our relationship with our neighbor. Jesus' ramping up of the commandments (not to abolish the Law, but to fulfill it) is a reminder that we are to do more than keep the law for the law's sake. Instead Jesus invites us to imagine a world where all are honored as persons who are truly beloved of God.

For the Gospel to be Good News, it must be proclaimed in a way that shows that it is about relationship. And that is a lot harder than handing out a list of rules.




