Too Good To Miss

ESPN.com reported that on May 17, 2011, 12-year-old little league pitcher Robert Knight pitched the game of his life. As batter after batter came to the plate for the opposing team in suburban Detroit, each player did his best to make his parents proud. Each tried, failed, again and again, to hit a pitch off the 5-foot-3inch, 100 pound Robert Knight.

Knight not only threw a perfect game (where no batter gets a hit), but all 18 batters he faced in the six-inning game struck out! The final batter to face Knight had worked the count to 3 and 0, but Knight came back to strike him out as well.

It's not that they didn't care. Robert's dad had driven his other son to another game and his mom was at a softball game of her own down the street. When Mrs. Knight did arrive to pick up her son, Robert's coach told her, "Oh, this wasn't the game for you to miss."

This perfect game was a perfect example of missing something truly great because of something good. Often, the real enemy of the Christian life is not the terrible evil deeds we might commit. No, the failure of many Christians and of many a church is that we are busy doing good things when God is willing to do something great in our lives.

So, what's the answer? It's not to stop and do nothing and wait for God to act. It's to seek God and His kingdom first and to abide in Him. That way we'll always be around when He does something really great.
