Reaping What We Sow

A young couple had just bought their first home, and one of their first projects was landscaping. They prepared the yard, installed a sprinkler system, and one day, when the weather was just right they seeded and watered the lawn, finishing after the sun went down.

For the next three weeks they faithfully tended the lawn, watering daily, shooing away birds, neighborhood cats, and roving children, and watched patiently for the first blades of grass to peek through. Nothing came up except a few weeds.

Then the husband came in one day and announced sheepishly to his wife, "I just found the bag in the garage that I thought had grass seed in it." "Well, what did you plant?" asked his wife. "KITTY LITTER," he replied with a sigh.

It's true in so many areas of life, isn't it? So often we do reap what we sow. The Apostle Paul said it precisely in his letter to the Galatians, "Do not be deceived, God is not mocked, for whatsoever a man sows, that he will also reap." (Galatians 6:7)

These words about reaping what we sow take on a very special meaning as we begin preparing for our 2012 Stewardship Campaign. This year our campaign will run for five weeks beginning September 25th. Our theme is: Generosity – A Habit of the Heart. Each week we will highlight one of our church vows – Prayers, Presence, Gifts, Service, and Witness.

When it comes to our giving we almost always reap what we sow. Take this past year for example. We're all aware of the great things that have happened in the life of our church over the past year. But those seeds were planted back last year when we made our commitments to the church. Those seeds that were planted last year opened a lot of doors of ministry for us through the rest of the year. Without those seeds we simply could not have come this far.

How far will we be able to go next year? How many doors of ministry will we be able to open? A lot of that depends on what seeds we plant in the next few weeks. And every seed is important. And quite frankly, if we're going to be the kind of church that God is calling us to be, then it's going to take each one of us planting as many seeds as possible. This is YOUR church and YOUR program and YOUR ministry. YOUR and MY commitment will make a difference in the harvest we reap next year.

With that in mind, I would ask that each of us begin to make our commitments to the church a matter of prayerful consideration. Let's plant our seeds and our gifts with joy and thanksgiving. And together let's be the church we are called to be.






Hand Bells

Ryan Craig Ruiz, a member of First United Methodist Church of Brenham, received a \$1,000 Gift of Hope Scholarship, awarded by the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry.

Ryan, the son of Rick and Brynn Ruiz, plans to attend Blinn College this fall after graduation from Brenham High School.

"The Karen Layman Gift of Hope Scholarship is awarded to about 250 undergraduate students who have been active and full members of The United Methodist Church for at least three years, have a 3.0 grade point average, and have demonstrated strong leadership in The United Methodist Church," said Allyson Collinsworth, director of the Office of Loans and Scholarships at the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry.

The United Methodist Church, through the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry's Office of Loans and Scholarships, awards about \$3 million in scholarships each year to undergraduate, graduate, and seminary students through more than 50 scholarship programs. Nearly \$2 million a year is distributed in loans to college students who are members of The United Methodist Church.

"Our scholarship programs further the mission of the church by increasing the access to higher education with the goal of developing principled Christian leaders for the church and the world," Collinsworth said.
