#### Stouffer's Food For Thought...

I am finding it to be such fun to build lamps as a hobby and to share some of that now and again. I am also finding joy in proclaiming that Light shines in the darkness – this Season after Epiphany has been quite an adventurous time for me. One of the things I am missing though is preaching the rich texts of First Corinthians. If I may suggest readings for this time of year, Paul's letters to the Corinthians would top the list. Here are some thoughts that came to me while studying and preparing for worship these past weeks. (I left them out of the message during worship because I really do think about our time!)

#### 1 Corinthians 1

# ...<sup>5</sup> for in every way you have been enriched in him, in speech and knowledge of every kind—<sup>6</sup> just as the testimony of Christ has been strengthened among you—<sup>7</sup> so that you are not lacking in any spiritual gift as you wait for the revealing of our Lord Jesus Christ.

From all God provides us, we have all we need to do all God calls us to do. We have been enriched in every way! The "testimony of Christ" – all that Jesus has done among us and through us – is stronger now than ever. Just ask each other "What has God done among us?" and answer each other "Look what God has done among us!" We are not lacking any spiritual gift, though we may be a little out of practice at using said gifts. Which is easily remedied!

# <sup>10</sup> Now I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you be in agreement and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same purpose.

Unity and uniformity are very, very different among the people of God! We are to be united mind and purpose. The unity of mind that Paul addresses here is the basis of operation for the Christian church. In terms of technology, this would be our "operating system." In terms thought processes, unity of mind would be our basic ideals, principles, standards. Grace comes to my mind. Amazing Grace, in fact, is what I hear. And love, honest and pure and complete – the Love of Jesus!

Unity of purpose is that of making disciples. Whatever other way we might talk about or name our mission or purpose or reason for being, we as part of the whole church, as part of the United Methodist Church, as a congregation and as individual Christians exist to make disciples of Jesus Christ by living among and loving all people.

Rehearsals will begin in February. The show date is on Mother's Day. The show will be announced soon!




## Vacation Bible School 2014 June 9-13
