A Day For Remembrance

On Sunday, November 4th, we will celebrate All Saints' Sunday. All Saints' Day is a time to remember Christians who have died in the faith.

All Saints' Day is much more than a Christian memorial day. The word saints as used in the New Testament means, "All Christians of every time and place." On All Saints' Day we celebrate our communion with Christ's universal church throughout all time and in all places. We are one with the dead who live in Christ and one with Christians of every denomination around the world.

In celebrating this ancient Christian observance, United Methodists recover something dear to John Wesley. In Wesley's journal, he makes it clear that he observed All Saints' each year as "a day of triumphant joy" and a day that he "peculiarly" loved.

This service is a deep remembrance in which we encounter anew the most profound dimension of what it is to be the church. It reminds us of those for whom the battle is over, the victory won, and also of our continuing pilgrimage toward God and the heavenly banquet. Holy Communion is celebrated on this day with a particular joy and solemnity. To render thanks to God for the lives and deaths of the saints is to recognize the common bond between the church on earth and the church triumphant in God's love.

For a little background, secular Halloween is October 31 and sacred All Saints' Day is November 1. Ancient lore held that Halloween was the time when the spirit world and the world of the living came closest together. One of the signposts of our faith is resurrection – the crucified Savior raised to life. We are a resurrection people. Our loved ones are not dead; they have been raised with Christ, who sent the Holy Spirit to dwell among us. The heavenly world, where we will meet those who have gone before is never far from us.

Sunday, November 4, we will observe the Festival of All Saints' as we pause to remember and give thanks for those persons of our congregation who have "fought the good fight" and "finished the course" since the last All Saints' Sunday one year ago. At the conclusion of the sermon we will read the roll of all our members who have been committed to their eternal resting place: Lois Houston, Nancy Atkinson, Nancy Coghlan, Mary Williamson, Elsie Guinn, Mary Katherine Pomykal, Betty Averitt, Jeannie Draehn, John Cantrell Plummer, Elizabeth Muckleroy, Tracy Meadows, C.M. Mathis, Virginia Scheffield, Kathy Buck, and Leroy Super. Let us come together as we remember and give thanks.


