



#### **Open Gates and Open Hearts**

Many Ukrainian Easter cards portray gardens with beautiful flowers — with an easily overlooked detail: the gate to the garden is left open just a bit. These cards give us a visual reminder of an Easter tradition in the Ukraine. During the season of Easter, doors are to be ajar. This symbolizes that our risen Lord has opened what is locked. Jesus has opened the door to heaven. And we, in turn, are to open up the door of our heart to Jesus.

What a beautiful picture of a wonderful truth. Christ has indeed opened the door of heaven. He has opened up eternal life to all who would enter in. What was hidden is now revealed. What was closed is now open.

Yet there is one door Christ cannot open. It is the door to your heart. Only you can do that. Only you can open your life to His love, His truth, His life. The real tragedy is not that Jesus had to die on the cross for our sins. That was the price for our freedom from sin and death. The resurrection proves that it was not in vain.

No, the real tragedy is that even with Christ going through all of that for us, there are still some people who refuse to let Him in. Have you opened your heart's door to Him? Have you let Him come in with all His glory and splendor? Have you experienced His joy and forgiveness? If not, leave your door ajar. He'll do the rest.
