

Pastor Bobbie Maltas

Pastor Bobbie has served the Texas Annual Conference of The United Methodist Church as a pastor for 22 years. The churches she has served include Cypress UMC, Bear Creek UMC, Cypress Trails UMC, Cleveland UMC, Mineola FUMC, and while in seminary she also served St. John the Apostle UMC in Arlington. She is a mom to Tara, now 23 years old, who lives in Michigan and is grandma to Alice, 16 months, who lives with Bobbie permanently

Community involvement is important to Bobbie. In each of the different church appointments she has found one way or another to volunteer her time. She believes that the church is not the focal point of a community but rather part of a network of people, agencies and organizations that works together to make the world a better place. Bobbie has volunteered and supported agencies near and dear to her heart such as women's shelters, food pantries, school districts, the foster care system, Scouts, animal shelters, and school organizations.

Giving time and attention directly to the Church is also important. Within the UMC, Bobbie has served on the District Committee on Ministry (DCOM) of the Central North District for five years, two of those as the chairperson. She has served the North District DCOM as chairperson for the past three years. She is currently on the Conference Board of Ordained Ministry. She loves the ministry of both the committee and the board because she has so many opportunities to guide ministry candidates through the process of becoming licensed or ordained. It's a blessing to share that journey with them and witness their growth and understanding of their call.

Bobbie graduated from The University of Texas in San Antonio with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology. She attended seminary at Perkins School of Theology at SMU and was ordained an elder in the TAC in 2002. Since then she has also been trained as a Stephen Leader and has completed an 18 month leadership training through the conference entitled Pastoral Leadership Project.

She's very excited about moving to Brenham and ministering alongside the people of Brenham FUMC. Bobbie is convinced that the best ministry happens when clergy and laity work together in the direction God leads. One of her favorite verses is from Luke 10:27, He (Jesus) answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself."
