SO, WHAT DOES A LAY LEADER DO?

That's a good question. Last May I spoke about it with Pastor Bill Taylor. I was looking for something to do to help at church, especially with the arrival of two new pastors. Pastor Bill suggested I look at assuming the position of lay leader. He described the position and got me a set of guidelines to review. After some detailed discussions with Pastor Bobbie, I agreed to assume the role.

The lay leader is the primary representative of the laity in the local church. He works to foster the role of the laity in making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world – our marching orders. In order to do this, he strives to understand the existing ministries within the church, the potential that exists in the diverse back-grounds and talents of the laity for new or improved ministries and the nature of the needs of our community, both local and beyond.

Having gathered that knowledge, he then tries to work within the church organization to make our various ministries as effective as possible. In order to do this, the lay leader becomes a member of the annual conference, church council, finance committee, nominations and leadership development committee and staff/pastor-parish (SPRC) committee. As if this isn't enough, I feel that the lay leader will need to work with the missions and evangelism committees on an as-need basis so I hope to do this also.

Obviously, the lay leader must do these activities in concert with the pastor. Pastor Bobbie and I meet on a regular basis to discuss an ever evolving game plan and how to effectively achieve these tasks.

By the way, I'm not just winging this on my own. Pastor Bobbie is a tremendous help and I have taken a lay servant training course.

I am currently in learn mode. I have started attending all three services – a different one each Sunday. I will soon start interacting with various church organizations, both adult and youth, to understand the work that we currently do and there's a lot of it. I will be asking for suggestions on improving existing or launching new ministries. I am also starting a study of our local community, Brenham and Washington county, to understand the nature of the community and the needs around us.

As annual conference comes nearer, I will be able to study the pre-conference journal and materials. If there are things that can impact our local church, I will communicate these and elicit your input. I will attend the conference and share information on it afterwards.

This doesn't sound too difficult, does it???

The 5th/6th Grade Confirmation class has been meeting on Sunday evenings to learn two basic things: What does it mean to give your life to Christ? And What does it mean to be a member of The United Methodist Church?

Part of the answer to both of those is that a Christian disciple and a member of The UMC serve God by serving their neighbor without expectation of reward or recognition. On Saturday, February 17, the confirmation class, along with several parents and mentors, traveled to the Brazos Valley Food Bank. We didn't know what work they would assign to us; we went simply to serve wherever they needed us.

We filled over 300 bags of food, milk and juice, which will be discreetly sent home in backpacks with school children so they have food for the weekend. During the week, school meal programs provide nutritional food but many children have nothing to bridge the hunger gap between Friday afternoon and Monday morning. We learned that on average, 1 in 4 households in the Brazos Valley with children are at risk of hunger. Children without proper nutrition have difficulties concentrating in school and are more prone to chronic illness that may hinder their growth and development.

Please join us in praying for the 50% of children living in our community who suffer from hunger each day.


