For as long as I have been involved in the planning and leading of worship I can remember the deep cry of my heart went mostly unnamed. That is, if I were pressed to say aloud or write what I was thinking or praying or hoping as we prepared for worship I am not certain that I could have given words to my prayer. This particular prayer was simply deep in my heart and soul as part of me! This last week God finally gave words to this prayer for me:

As I prepare for worship, I pray that -

Every act of worship demonstrates God's faithfulness.

Every act of worship elicits our faithful response.

Every participant knows the abiding presence of Christ.

Our lives continue to be shaped by the power

and presence of the Holy Spirit.

As I think about worship yesterday, look forward to worship next Sunday, and think about all that will be between these two Sundays, I am reminded that in all of life we are called to worship God with our whole being. This reminder changes my prayer from "every act of worship" to "every breath I breathe," "every thought I think," "every word I speak," and "every I action I engage." At lunch on Sunday I learned a new phrase, "dum spiro spera," "as I breathe, I hope." It was another customer's family motto that was on the back of his vest. If I were to name my hope, it would begin with this prayer.
