



The Most Important Gift


We live in a day and time when there's so much pressure to give our children everything that our culture says they need to have. You know what I'm talking about. We've got to give our children the right clothes, the most expensive baseball equipment, the best computer, the fanciest cell phone, the nicest car. We've got to make sure they go to the right schools and attend the best camps and belong to the acceptable organizations. The list goes on and on.

I've had parents come and talk with me about the pressure they feel within our community to have all the "right things" for their children so their children will not feel left out, yet they know they simply cannot afford to buy all those "right things." They feel guilty that they cannot provide for their children the things that other children might have.

Certainly there are a lot of things that we can give our children. And, yes, there's a lot of pressure to give our children the "right things," the things they need. But I believe the most important gift we can give our children is the gift of the church. I believe that's especially true in our society expressed through the Body of Christ, the Church. There is no gift to our children that will mean more, last longer, or have greater impact throughout their life than the gift of the church. That gift is one that will provide the foundation of faith on which our children will build the rest of their life. Nothing is more important.

I'm glad that we have a day that honors our mothers and emphasizes the importance of being a family. In some of the churches I have served there was a tradition of placing two roses on the altar, a red and a white rose to honor both mothers who are living and mothers who have died. Sunday, May 12th is Mother's Day and our children will be singing at all three services. Sunday, May 19th is Unity Sunday. It is also the day on which we will receive into the membership of our church seven members of this year's Confirmation Class. It is an important time for each of these young people as they profess their faith in Jesus Christ and it is important for each of us in the life of this congregation, for on this day we will once again give to these special young people the most important gift – the gift of the church. Don't let anything come between you and your presence with us in worship that Sunday. It is indeed a most important day as we share the most important gift.
