Thank you for your gracious reception over the past four weeks as I have assumed the position of intentional interim pastor. As has been previously stated I will be here through June 30th and on July 1st a newly appointed pastor will begin his/her ministry with you. Transitions are always difficult but I sense everyone is working hard to ease this process.

Your staff parish committee (a group of nine persons elected by your Charge Conference) has met and begun the process of developing a pastoral profile under the leadership of the chair Mrs. Jody Tyson. This profile is a guideline for the Bishop and his cabinet to ensure that the most qualified effective pastor will be appointed.

Although our new pastor will not begin until July 1st, this person will likely be appointed in late February or early March. The timeline is short. You can help by giving your input to anyone of the nine members of the committee and they will share this information with the full committee. The members of the pastor parish committee are:





World Changing Days

Sunday night we had the first meeting of the 2017 Confirmation Class. As I looked around our over-flowing classroom I thought about this newsletter article I wrote in 2015. I thought it might be interesting to read again.

Fifty years ago a Philadelphia congregation watched as three 9-year-old boys were baptized and joined the church. Not long after, unable to continue with its dwindling membership, the church sold the building and disbanded.

One of those boys was Dr. Tony Campolo, author, alumnus and professor emeritus of Christian sociology at Eastern University in St. David's, Pennsylvania. Dr. Campolo remembers: "Years later when I was doing research in the archives of our denomination, I decided to look up the church report for the year of my baptism. There was my name and Dick White's. He's now a missionary. Bert Newman, now a professor of theology at an African seminary, was also there. Then I read the church report for "my" year. "It has not been a good year for our church. We have lost 27 members. Three joined, and they were only children."

The kingdom of God operates from a different perspective than the rest of the world. The pastor of that church so many years ago saw only children. But God saw a world-wide ministry. The pastor saw only a dwindling church. But God saw the countless lives touched by the ministries of those three boys.

The 2017 Confirmation class has 17 Confirmands. Can you imagine the impact these young people will have on our world? I can't even begin. You can participate and help me by praying for all of us:
