Welcome to the season of Lent! In the early church, Lent was the time when new prospective church members would prepare to become part of the church. They went through a time of intense fasting, prayer, and scripture reading before they could be baptized and receive the Eucharist for the first time.

For us, it’s an invitation to examine our spiritual lives. It’s usually a time when we fast and I encourage you to do that should you feel led. But since we began our year with 21 days of fasting and prayer, I want to invite you to do something different. Instead of *giving up* something, I want you to *take on or put on* something. Galatians 3:27 says, “For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”

Here are some ideas to put on Christ during Lent:

—Get up 15 minutes earlier each morning for prayer and scripture reading. There’s no better way to start your day, and I promise you it will make a difference!

—Commit to coming to worship every Sunday during Lent. Gathering for worship with the body of Christ is our greatest calling.

—Find a way to serve in the church. There’s a role for everyone in the ministries of the church, and if you find the right opportunity for you, it will be life-giving! I’d love to meet with you and help determine the best way for you to serve.

—Find a way to serve in the community. Jesus spent most of his time in the community making an impact on people’s lives. We are the body of Christ and are called to do the same!

—Come pray in our prayer chapel. Make it something that you do weekly. Just come by the Church office during office hours, and we’ll be glad to provide you with a key.

Pick one, pick all, or pick something completely different. But let’s all put on Christ!

A MOMENT FOR MISSIONS

“Likewise every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit.”
Matthew 7: 17

This verse is very clear but what about the trees that do not bear good or bad fruit. There is talk about the good fruit that is coming but there is no fruit to be harvested. There are many reasons given for this failed crop-it has been too hot, too cold, too wet, too dry, God must not have wanted that tree to bear fruit-but the fact remains there is no fruit.

There were many times in my life when I planted trees that I knew would bear good fruit. I worked the soil. I watered it. I pulled weeds but I had so many other things I needed to do. I had to go to work, take classes, cut the grass, and get the car fixed. I still had to find time for my wife and family. The care of those trees moved further and further down my “To Do” List.

Well, those trees did not bear any fruit. No surprise there, but that was ok because I had enough excuses to justify the lack of good fruit. It was the trees’ failing, not mine.

I think sometimes God gives us a task that could produce good fruit but it may need more time and energy than we are willing to give to it. We do a little, pray about it, make a committee, move some papers around and then put more time in finding excuses than we did in doing the work. When there is no fruit, it must be that it was not in God’s plan because it couldn’t be because I failed to put the time and energy into it.
