The financial report printout was distributed, reviewed, and approved. Stewardship covered-dish lunch will be held on November 12. Pledge cards will be distributed on November 5.

• Building & Grounds:

Fence around outside garbage cans has been finished (painted white). Choir room door canopy has been installed. Nursery child's toilet has been repaired. AV System—Hill's will charge \$80 per hour to locate projector's source of power. Best to just have them to add circuit box in hall and bring wire to the new box.


