Notes to Financial Statement - December 2016

- 1. Cash on Hand remaining after subtracting Unreserved Fund/Liability Accounts is \$20,588.69. This balance is \$159.63 less than November. This includes Non-Profit Checking and Money Market Account which includes the Gift Account. The balance in the Gift Account is \$15,790.87. The balance in Non-Profit checking was \$6,560.48 at month end. The balance in Non Profit Checking is \$1,778.80 greater than the end of November. No money was transferred from the Money Market account to Non Profit Checking in December. The balance in the Money Market Account at month end was \$8811.99. The Endowment Fund gained \$449.52 in December and the Investment Account gained \$505.92. The detail is reported on the Designated Accounts Report.
- 2. Pledges were \$1,262.00 over budget for the month and \$7,875.00 over budget YTD thru December. Income for the month was \$2,237.76 over budget and \$16,661.00 over budget YTD thru December. Expenses for the month were \$938.48 less than income and \$1,502.22 under budget. The projected loss for the month was \$2,801.50. The loss Year to Date is \$10,495.69 but was projected to be \$33,269.00.
- 3. All departments were under budget for the month and for the year. All department chairs worked to keep cost down and we did not have any major repairs to the building this year. We are blessed to have generous givers. If you have any questions, please let me know.
