SESSION HIGHLIGHTS: MARCH 14, 2017

- Seven members of Session were present; Eddie Coggins was unable to attend, and we are all mourning the loss of our dear Johnnie Suggs.
- All bills and invoices have been paid through March 10th, and QuickBooks posting is up to date. There was no Financial Report produced for February.
- Treasurer responsibilities were discussed, and going forward there will be co-treasurers. Phil Griffin and Barbara Manning were elected by Session as Interim Co-Treasurers.
- B&G received a quote to replace lights throughout the church to energy efficient lighting at a cost of \$1,592 after rebate. Session approved the upgrade. The cost to repaint the front Fellowship Hall with two coats of Surewall paint will be \$3600.
- Christian Education is working on a job description for a Youth Leader, and making plans for Vacation Bible School this summer.
- Personnel plans to take down Art Work in the hall at the Main Entrance and install a bulletin board.
- Service will sponsor a Meal of Grace at CCM on May 5th. The committee will also be looking for volunteers to participate in the Salvation Army's Ringing of the Bell one day during the Christmas season.
- Witness is working on several projects: Craguns in concert on April 1 at 6:30 pm (love offering accepted); Assist with the planning of Community Fun Day on May 13 from 2:00-5:00 pm; Hosting a stand in front of the church on Everybody's Day and opening the church bathroom facilities and parking for the day; Submitting tentative request for Christmas Float to Thomasville's Director of Tourism (discussion included decorations for float and placement on church front lawn).
- Worship plans are to join Memorial United Methodist Church for Maundy Thursday Seder supper on April 13. Easter Sunday will include a trumpet musician (an 8th grader) that will play once outside and once inside. We will have Butterfly larva again this year as part of our celebration.
- Other business: Plans are being made to have a team approach to be trained on A/V System, Electronic Sign, and Announcements on the Narthex monitor. Session approved applying to Presbyterian Church USA (PCUSA) General Assembly for a grant to benefit Huntington's Research. This would honor Gail Moore and possibly help Kathy—the daughter of Gail and Jim Moore. Pastor Jennie will be out of the office on May 1st to attend a Pastor's Retreat.

ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS

The Adult Sunday School Class is beginning a Lenten study, "The God We Can Know." It explores the "I Am" sayings from the Gospel of John: the bread of Life; the Light of the World; the Good Shepherd; the True Vine; the Way, the Truth, and the Life; the Resurrection and the Life. This book/DVD study is about knowing God, specifically knowing God through Jesus. The Adult class meets Sunday mornings at 9:45 in the Fellowship Hall.
