SESSION HIGHLIGHTS ~ MAY 9, 2017

(Seven members were present with one absent.)

Committee Reports:

- Treasurer: A summary of our financial position was provided and a printout will be e-mailed soon. QuickBooks has been reconciled to the bank statement through March. Tom Byrnes communicated that the Endowment account increased 1% and the Investment account has increased 1.3%
- Building &Grounds: The library is being used to store the old lighting that was replaced. Anyone in need can help themselves. The bulletin board from upstairs is being refreshed and will be placed on the left wall at the parking lot door. We will be putting up a canopy over the choir room door soon.
- Christian Education: We have been searching for a Youth leader for nine (9) months, with no success. We need help. Pastor Jennie suggested asking Memorial United Methodist Church if they had any young people that would be interested in our Youth Church. Phil Griffin moved, Jim Moore seconded a motion to pay Julie Tyson and Jennifer Hege \$10 each for their time in Youth Church. Session approved this motion effective May 14th.
- Congregational Care: The committee is looking into putting some parameters around acknowledging our children's accomplishments throughout life to ensure all the children get recognized equally.
- Service: Tom Byrnes reported that there were 35 served a meal at CCM on Friday, May 5th. There was a very good response from our congregation for the Young Mothers in need in our community.
- Witness: On-going work on Community Fun Day. We had a pre-meeting May 7th to review the artwork plans and to schedule a working meeting on June 4th. Pastor Jennie had talked with a gentleman that had made the JOY sign and he let her know where she could get the plans.
- Worship: May 10th is the last Wednesday night for choir practice. Women's Sunday is May 21st. Laura Agner will begin as temporary Music Director May 28th through July 23rd while Yulia is on vacation. During this time, we will have solos and duets with choir practice at 10:00 am on Sundays. On June 4th, we will provide communion to shut-ins by the Griffin's and the Bennett's.

• We are still looking for individuals to be trained on the Sound/Projection System. We want to have a team approach so no one person is responsible every Sunday.

New Business:

- Joe Bennett moved and Julie Tyson seconded a motion to convene the Transition Team as Pastor Jennie's contract is up the end of July. Session approved.
- A Thank You note will be sent to the Seventh Day Adventists for their gracious gift of the painting of Jesus, which was hung in the Fellowship Hall, as well as for the puzzle to add to our collection.
