- On 4/28 Eddie Coggins will BBQ to raise funds for books for the Thomasville City Schools; Tommy Hodges will DJ the event, there will be a silent auction.

# Worship:

- Lenten Services going well; Easter items will be put out in the Narthex
- There will be a new trumpet player this year for the Easter service
- Four people have been trained on the A/V sound board
- A seminary student will be in the pulpit on April 8.

# TRANSITIONAL MINISTER'S REPORT:

- Craguns will not be available in May so we are looking to the fall for a concert.
- Confirmation class meets on Tuesdays at 5:30 PM.—there are 3 children and 2 adults, should finish up in May
- Pastor Jennie developed acknowledgment cards and printed them for the counters
- TCS book project: 23,000 books have been reserved as interim Superintendent of TCS sent \$1000 to hold them for us. There is a need to raise \$5000 more for this project, divided by the number of churches and other organizations that are participating
- Good Friday Cross Walk on March 30 at 11:00 AM beginning at MUMC (Pastor Jennie will be out front for the stop at FPC)
- Salem Presbytery is sponsoring an 18-month training event to improve the level, generosity and financial stewardship among churches and their members. - The author of Waking Up White, Debby Irving, will be at FPC-Greensboro on Sept 17 & 18. The cost of her visit is \$4500. FPC-G is offering organizations to co-sponsor the visit.
