SESSION HIGHLIGHTS

There were nine present at this month's Session meeting.

Minutes of Stated Meeting of Session on March 13, 2018 were approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

There have been issues with the new version of QuickBooks, including not capturing all data needed to continue with 2018 accounting information. It is recommended by the financial committee that FPC outsource the Accounts Payables to VAS who will charge \$150/mo. to handle all steps currently taken by the treasurer. A copy of a quote was provided for all to review. There was discussion and Session approved to outsource the Accounts Payable.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- Building & Grounds: Need new computer board on furnace; Contacting North State Communications about getting an additional router for the tech room
- Christian Education: Continuing with previously stated projects
- Congregational Care: Exploring options for setting up a telephone tree
- Outreach: On April 28, Eddie Coggins will BBQ to raise funds for books for the Thomasville City Schools, including a silent auction and entertainment by DJ Tommy Hodges. Flyers will be posted, and 150 tickets at \$10 each will be available to sell for the event. Auction items are being donated and stored in nursery.
- Personnel: Continuing to search for another nursery attendant
- Worship: Will be setting up a schedule for cross training within A/V team soon

TRANSITIONAL MINISTER'S REPORT:

- Would like to begin "Jesus on Tap" at the Copper Steel, meeting from 5:30-6:30 each Monday or maybe combine with Sunday Seekers
