They read their statements of faith they had written as a result of the confirmation classes they had completed. Both will be presented to the congregation on May 20, 2018.

Minutes of Stated Meeting of Session on April 10, 2018 were reviewed due to changes, and approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Melissa Varner of VAS will be handing our Accounts Payable starting next month.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Building and Grounds: The committee is working on the TO DO list. Installing WiFi extenders for Education Building so there will be WiFi throughout the church. Bill Varner, who rents the Manse, has experienced declining health and will be moving out of the house during the next month. Jim Moore will discuss/renegotiate our contract with Advantage Properties (realtor) if they wish to continue managing the property. FPC received check of \$37,000 for sale of house on Cramer Street. Session had previously voted to put half of the sale funds into the Investment Account and half into the church Money Market Account. A thank you note will be mailed to attorney Paul Mitchell, along with a small token of our appreciation, for all the work he and his office staff put into this sale at no charge.

Christian Education: Committee will be meeting, plans are for the youth to take charge of Youth Church.

Congregational Care: There will be training soon for the Phone Tree.

Outreach: The BBQ and Silent Auction was a huge success. We brought in over \$3600, and money is still coming in. Session thanked the Outreach Committee for the wonderful job they did putting together this event. It was nicely laid out and well organized. The CCM meal in June will be spaghetti. The next project will be collecting eye glasses for Presbytery.

Personnel: There is a person interested in working in the nursery, and they will soon be interviewed. Jennifer and Carolyn will be serving in the nursery on May 20, and Jennifer will help with Pizza with the Pastor. There will be no Youth Church on May 20, due to baptisms and confirmations.

Worship: The A/V training session was cancelled due to lack of availability. Josh Waldron will serve as our summer music director beginning June 3rd through July 22nd, at \$150 per week.

TRANSITIONAL MINISTER'S REPORT:

Pastor Jennie will begin "Jesus on Tap" at the Chair City Tavern from 5:30-6:30 each Wednesday evening. Session is taking a look at options for using the "other end of the facility." Julie Tyson shared some of her thoughts with regards to this subject, such as setting up to offer shelter for those in need. Thomasville City Schools Summer Book Project was so much more successful than we had imagined. Pastor Jennie will host a meeting of Thomasville clergy on Monday, May 21 in an effort to begin regular meetings of the Thomasville Ministerial Group.

Jim Moore reported on the Salem Presbytery meeting held on Tuesday, May 15 at Alamance PC in Greensboro.
