# **New Logo Design for Salem Presbytery**

Overall in our concept, we wanted to create a design that would be timeless while representing what Salem Presbytery is all about – who we are as Salem Presbytery, our mission statement, and showing our geographical location.

To begin with, our design is created on the foundation of Church, with our design portraying a **stained glass Church window**.



## **Incorporated Presbytery's Mission Statement**

We as Salem Presbytery strive:

- to be a visible witness to Jesus Christ-REACH (NCD's and Church Growth)
- to equip and strengthen our congregations and leaders for ministry in the world-EQUIP (Christian Education)
- & to inspire and model local and global mission-SEND. (Missions)

#### 1. First Window represents Reach

- Arms are wide open to everyone
- Reach Figure resembles many forms: a Pastor, a congregational member, or Jesus reaching out to others



#### 2. Second Window represents Equip

- Equip is represented by the PC (USA) symbol. We are a part of them and they a part of us.
- PC(USA) gives us the tools to educate and provide resources to equip our presbytery
- & we wanted to portray many equip symbols in our logo that were already in the PC(USA) symbol
  - Cross
  - Dove
  - Bible
  - Pulpit
  - Fire



- 3. Third Window represents **Send** 
  - The world symbol represents that we send our members out into the world to work for God
  - Inspiring Local and Global Missions-like Mexico Mission, Habitat for Humanity's Unity Build and so many more missions that churches dedicate themselves to take part in.



## Logo elements:

Concept: Stained Glass Windows with symbols, and water lines below

- The 3's Pattern
  - o 3 parts of Presbytery Mission Statement -Reach, Equip, Send
  - Holy Trinity
  - 3 Neighborhoods
  - o & 3 colors in the stained glass windows are
    - 3 primary colors (cyan, magenta and yellow) representing that we are diverse & are multicultural
    - Geographical location
      - Portrays Mountain ridges such as Blue Ridge Pkwy
    - Important to have the design flow across the various elements & join all together, showing our cohesiveness among each window and within each element of Salem Presbytery.
  - o 3 wavy blue lines portray the waters within our Presbytery like the Yadkin, and Dan Rivers, and continues our 3's theme.
