Lent Is A Good Time To Begin Adult Sunday School


The Adult Sunday School class will continue our February focus on Signs and Wonders that Jesus per-

SPIRITUAL RENEWAL 2023 ECUMENICAL WEEKEND SATURDAY & SUNDAY MARCH 4 & 5

SATURDAY WORKSHOPS LED BY REV. DR. RANDY WOODLEY

Scholar, author, farmer and professor Randy Woodley will lead workshops and preach during this year's Ecumenical Spiritual Renewal Weekend in Florence on March 4 and 5. Rev. Dr. Woodley, the author of both histories and devotionals, is Distinguished Professor of Faith and Culture at George Fox University and the founder of Eloheh Farms in Northwest Oregon.



The Spiritual Renewal Weekend, sponsored by a 5-church Florence-based coalition in its 28th year, will be held at the Presbyterian Church of the Siuslaw, 3996 Hwy. 101. Three workshops on Saturday – at 10, 1 and 2:15 – will deal with "Rooted in Our Story," "Growing Our Roots: Understanding the Indigenous Worldview," and "Deepening Our Roots: Sustaining the Earth." Rev. Dr. Woodley will preach on "Jesus' Mission and Shalom," based on Luke 4, during Sunday's worship service, which begins at 10:30.

Rev. Dr. Woodley, a Keetoowah Cherokee legal descendant, is the author of more than a dozen books, including *Becoming Rooted*, *Living in Color*, *The Harmony Tree*, and *Indigenous Theology and the Western Worldview*. A native of Michigan, he received his doctorate from Asbury Theological Seminary in Kentucky and was ordained by the American Baptist Churches in the USA in Oklahoma.






Online Contributions



Amplify Videos



Recipe Corner

Winter Vegetable Soup

Contributed by Diane Haworth Taken from the Free Lunch Soup Recipes booklet

Ingredients:

1 cup chopped onion
1/2 cup sliced celery
1 large peeled potato, cut in 1/2 inch cubes
1 cup peeled, sliced carrots
1 beef bouillon cube
1 tsp. salt, 1/2 tsp. basil leaves, 1/4 tsp. black pepper
1-1/2 cups halved zucchini slices
1 (7 oz.) can whole kernel corn, undrained
1 tbsp. flour
2/3 cup evaporated milk
1/2 cup shredded Cheddar cheese (more for garnish)

Directions:

Sauté' onion and celery with 2 tbsp. butter until tender. Add potato, carrots, 2 cups water, bouillon cube, and seasonings. Heat to boiling. Reduce heat, cover, gently boil 30 minutes. Stir in zucchini and corn. Boil gently 30 minutes. Combine flour with small amount of milk. Stir in remaining milk and add to mixture. Cook over medium heat until just comes to boil. Remove from heat and add cheese until melted.

Yield: 4 - 6 servings
