
### **Adult Sunday School to Study Hebrews**

The Adult Sunday School class will resume meeting on Jan. 7, 2024 and each Sunday following at 9:00 am for a study of the New Testament book of Hebrews. Our video will feature a short presentation by David deSilva. Dr. deSilva is a professor at Ashland Theological Seminary where he currently serves as Trustees' Distinguished Professor of New Testament and Greek.

Beginning with a short video presentation of one of the primary points which the author of the Letter to the Hebrews presents and several questions raised for Christians hearing these words, Dr. deSilva presents us with questions for us to consider in the discussion following the video.

Each week we begin in the Sanctuary for the short video presentation before moving to the smaller choir room for our discussion. We finish our discussion in plenty of time for the 10:30 am worship. Come join us at 9:00 am beginning January 7, 2024.

# Storyteller Jennifer Yocum to Lead Ecumenical Spiritual Renewal Workshops

Rev. Dr. Jennifer Yocum, (United Church of Christ) will lead two sessions on the subject "Who is My Neighbor: A Storytelling Workshop for Making Spiritual Connection," the theme of the 2024 Ecumenical Spiritual Renewal Weekend February 10 and 11, sponsored by the five mainline churches in Florence.

The weekend's activities will be held at the Presbyterian Community Church, 3996 No Hwy 101. Florence UMC and the Presbyterians are two of the sponsors, along with New Life Lutheran, St. Andrew's Episcopal, and Saint Mary, Our Lady of the Dunes. Catholic churches.

The storytelling workshop begins at 10:30 a.m. Saturday, February 10. With a break for lunch served at the church, the session will resume at 1 p.m. and conclude at 2:30 p.m. A joint worship service, with Rev. Yocum preaching, will be held the following day, Sunday, February 11, at 10:30 a.m.

Dr. Yocum describes herself as a storyteller, kayaker, singer, and maker of things that get her hands dirty. She wrote her doctoral dissertation on the power of storytelling to cross progressive/conservative divides. She is deeply delighted to live in Florence with her sweetie, their two dogs, and a growing circle of friends.

- ♦2 lbs smaller variety pretzels
- ♦1 envelope Ranch dressing mix
- ♦1 bottle butter-flavored Orville Redenbacher popcorn oil
- ♦2 tbls dill weed
- ♦ 1/4 tsp garlic powder
- ♦ 1/4 tsp onion salt

Mix oil and dry ingredients together until well mixed. Pour over pretzels, stirring often until soaked into pretzels. Place in a well sealed container and let stand at least 24 hours, stirring occasionally. The longer they sit, the better they are!
