Florence Food Share is partnering with United Way of Lane County and Door Dash to offer small deliveries to our clients in the local Florence area. This service comes as an addition to our existing full pantry delivery service.

Ride United delivery orders placed before the end of day Tuesday will arrive Thursday of the same week. Any orders placed after Tuesday will be delivered the following Thursday.



Excerpts from a letter of the Executive Director of Camp & Retreat Ministries, Todd Bartlett...

April 21, 2022

"The Oregon-Idaho Board of Camp and Retreat Ministries has launched "Lighting the Way to a Brighter Future". This will raise \$75,000 to help us become more environmentally friendly and increase our chances for long-term sustainability, by bringing solar power to the Alton L. Collins Retreat Center and Wallowa Lake Camp in 2022."...

..."Some benefits that we can expect from these two projects:

- Supply approximately 242,500 kWh of clean and sustainable power from the sun each year, eliminating more than 189 tons of greenhouse gas emissions, equivalent to not driving a car approximately 426,949 miles, or not burning 190,868 pounds of coal annually.
- For the next 25 years, these panels will save the Alton L. Collins Retreat Center an estimated \$432,684 in electric bills and Wallowa Lake an estimated \$154,000 in electric bills. With panels expected to last longer than 25 years, there will be even greater savings.
- Create a unique new relationship between the Alton L. Collins Retreat Center and its community, by allowing community members to earn a return from investing in the solar project."...

..."you have two ways that you can support this project financially.

First, you can donate to Camp and Retreat Ministries either as a one-time donation (check mailed to the camping office, address below) or online [here](#), or as an on-going donation (online, or call 503-802-9214 or email Holly@umoi.org if you need assistance with this). Help us reach our goal of \$75,000.

Second, you can invest in this project. By doing so, you contribute the amount you desire (in multiples of \$1,000) through the Oregon Clean Power Cooperative (OCPC), and you will receive 4% return on your investment over 10 years. 

Bottle Drop – for Camperships

Florence UMC's account with the Oregon Beverage Recycling Cooperative (OBRC) "Bottle Drop" program allows everyone who has one of our tagged bags to contribute the value of their returnable bottles and cans to the church.

Kids going to Methodist camp, their friends, relatives, and everyone in the congregation, can pitch in and fill bags to benefit the program.

We hope Bottle Drop is a win-win for our campers.

Pick up a blue bag, sticker, and card at the back of church.

- Attach the sticker on the bag
- Bring the bag to a Bottle Drop station at the north side of Fred Meyer
- Use the paper card to unlock the door at the Bottle Drop
- Scan the card as indicated, open the door and place your tagged bag on the chute inside
- Bottle Drop does the rest – counts the contents of the bag and credits our account
