- ♥ **To the Family of Jack Nida upon his death on Saturday, August 24, 2018.** Jack, a member since November 1997 and his wife Jean were members of The Joy Class and active in several ministries. Jack was most notably known for his expertise in upgrading the sanctuary sound system and securing and training additional sound technicians. He was also known for his love of country music, playing the dobro (an American brand of resonator guitar); and writing his family history. While at MFUMC, Jack authored the first of three volumes of his family history titled *The Family von Nida from Germany to America 1262-1998*. He is also the author of *Roane County* in collaboration with the Roane County (West Virginia) Historical Society for the *Images of America Series*.

After his retirement, Jack and Jean would spend several months each year at Amma in Roane, WV, Jack's birth home built by his father in 1929; travel the U.S and Germany to research his family roots; and play his dobro for 10 years with The Traditional Country Band of which he was a member.

Jack is survived by his wife Jean, daughter Sandra Nida, son Randall C. Nida and wife Zuan, and grandsons Randall Jr., James Jackson and Thomas Jefferson.

A memorial service for Roy J. "Jack" Nida was Thursday, August 30, 6:00 p.m., at Newton Baptist Church, 790 Hollywood Road, Newton, West Virginia.
