### SANCTUARY ROOF NEEDS



REPLACING

The Trustees have been working to repair or replace all church roofs during the last two years. Repairs were made a year ago to replace some slate looking asbestos shingles and ridge flashing on the sanctuary roof. The educational building roof will be repaired and recoated during this next month.

During our review of quotes for replacement of the sanctuary roof, we found a report showing the current roof was installed in 1947. Because of restrictions on the use of over 65% of the Trustee funds, a capital drive and hopefully grants will be needed to pay for part of the \$170,000 replacement of the sanctuary roof. The Trustees are looking at a grant from the Fund for Sacred Places. It has restrictions on when you can start a capital drive and a long application process. The capital drive should be between \$60,000 and \$100,000. Please pray for the Trustees and the sources of funds.
