#### St. Paul's,

Welcome to Advent. As we begin December we also begin the season of Advent as we prepare our hearts and lives to celebrate the birth of Jesus on Christmas. In worship this Advent we are going to be focusing on some of the questions that are found in the Christmas story in Luke.

We will begin Advent with the question

Zechariah offers the angel after the

announcement that Zechariah and his wife

Elizabeth will have a son, "How will I know this
is so?" (Luke 1:18). We will discuss the

questions of doubt that Zechariah raises and
the questions of doubt in our own lives. The

considering a question from the crowd about

Zechariah and Elizabeth's son John, "What
then will this child become?" (Luke 1:66). In
the midst of a busy season I encourage you to
make time to join us in worship.

In addition, I want us all to be aware of some special events that will be happening in our church in December. The children and youth will present their Christmas program in worship on December 17th. Because Christmas Eve is on a Sunday this year we will have two opportunities to worship together. During our regular worship time at 10:00am we will have a Christmas Eve service that will be designed especially with our families in mind. Then at 7:00pm we will hold our traditional Christmas Eve service. Each service

will have its unique design so feel free to join us for both services on Christmas Eve or whatever one fits your schedule best if you have other commitments on that day.

As we prepare to celebrate the birth of our Savior, I encourage us all to take time this Advent season to prepare our hearts and lives for the coming of Christ. In the midst of everything that comes with the Christmas season take some time to gather in worship, read the Christmas story in the scripture, and serve others.
