St. Paul's,

Happy February! As we enter this month I give thanks for our church family and the many ways that we continue to be in ministry and mission with one another. In our worship service we will be spending February discussing John 1:29-51. At the beginning of this scripture we get this experience of John the Baptist, "The next day he saw Jesus coming towards him and declared 'Here is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!³⁰This is he of whom I said, "After me comes a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me."³¹I myself did not know him; but I came baptizing with water for this reason, that he might be revealed to Israel.' ³²And John testified, 'I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. ³³I myself did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water said to me, "He on whom you see the Spirit descend and

remain is the one who baptizes with the Holy Spirit." ³⁴And I myself have seen and have testified that this is the Son of God. '" (John 1:29-34). John the Baptist is able to proclaim the good news of who Jesus is in the world and in his life. And we will be discussing how we to might be better prepared to share the good news of Christ with those we encounter daily. The second half of this scripture is the gospel of John's version of the calling

TRUSTEE REPORT

Trustee board members have acquired a city grant to help with the repairs to the educational roof. Gary Arnold continues to seek quotes for the replacement of the church's main roof. More shingles have fallen off the roof, and Rich Kinstler has done some caulking to try and help with this issue. Gary replaced the bulbs in the fellowship hall with LED ones. John Patterson has been busy painting the doors inside the church. A clean up day is being planned for in the spring. If you see something that needs cleaned, painted, or repaired please let Gary Arnold know. Sweeping and Cleaning continues each week with **Rich, Duane and Jean Hoffert Marilou** Hill and John Patterson. <u>Administrative Council</u> <u>Meeting Highlights</u>

Shirley Smith was unable to attend the meeting, so Bill Daniel led the meeting. He opened with Devotions on Peter walking on the water and stepping out of our comfort zone. The meeting was opened with prayer by Bill also.

Finance report: There were roughly 63 identifiable givers in 2015 we were down to 60 in 2016, with an increased loss of almost \$9000 vs \$4000 the year before. We did spend less in 2016, and Rich and Sandy are doing all they can to reduce expenses. For the year 2017 as with most people hospitalization costs have increased significantly for Pastor Hannah the cost is now the same for a single person as it is for a family.

Trustee report: Trustees met last week they had applied for a city grant to repair the educational wing roof, that grant was approved on Jan 17, 2017. They will pay for 50% of the cost. The quote submitted was for 9,890.00. The Gym roof also needs repair, but they don't have a second quote in place yet. John Patterson has been busy painting the interior and exterior doors. Led lamps were recommended to cut down on energy costs, and have been replaced in the sanctuary and other areas already, with more to come. We are still working on a quote for the main roof replacement, and there have been more shingles come off, Rich was able to get up on the roof and liquid nail them into place for a temporary fix.

Education Committee report: Christmas program was a success. There are only 3 more lessons and Youth Club will be holding their closing program for the year, attendance has been consistent.

It was noted that Rich Kinstler has resigned as chair of the Sharing Kitchen Board. The board will meet in Feb and discuss who will be taking on this role.

Youth Report: There will be a district lock-in March 10-11th some of the teens will be going. They are planning a Spaghetti Dinner for March 19th after Sunday school. Donations will be helpful and they will be asking for them soon. The Youth will also be doing a drive for the Humane Society and will be collecting items they need for the animals. This will take place in late March or early April. Financial donations will also be accepted, the youth will be responsible for taking the items to the shelter and donating them.

Pastor Hannah's report: We will be holding the chili cook off on February 19th after Sunday school. Chris Armstrong will be organizing the event. Lent begins on March 1st this year. We will hold Ash Wednesday and Maundy Thursday Services together with Faith UMC. They will host Ash Wednesday and we will host Maundy Thursday. I will be offering a Lent Bible study probably on Wednesday nights starting on March 8th more information and topic to come.

There was not any unfinished business to discuss.

New Business: Ginny Faeth will be going on a mission trip to Cork Ireland from July 21st-31st of this year along with Youth from Collins UMC. She is in need of donations to help her get there. She needs to raise 2971.00 to cover the trip. There is a payment due of 1500.00 by Feb 1st. We will be putting inserts in the bulletin to try and get the word out for her. There will be a Spaghetti Dinner at Collins UMC on March 4th at 6:30 pm to help raise money for the Youth that are going on the mission trip.

Meeting was adjourned, next meeting set for February 23rd, 2017 at 7:00 pm.
