Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Many of you know that my life scripture is Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

As a planner myself, I find great comfort in the fact that God is also planning, making plans for me and for you and for all of humanity...making plans for our church and for the greater church universal. In this Cooperative Parish, we will both serve the congregations of Tiffin St. Paul's, Republic Trinity, Melmore UMC, Sycamore UMC and Union Salem UMC. I will remain as the lead pastor at St. Paul's and Republic Trinity, where I will oversee the administration, worship and life of the congregations. Pastor Amy will serve as lead pastor at Melmore UMC, Sycamore UMC and Union Salem UMC. While we are both appointed jointly to the parish, each congregation will have a

consistent pastoral presence. We will work together as a team to support one another and to find ways that our churches can maintain their own identities, while working together to strengthen some ministries.

This is not a new model for us, as we have worked in a connectional ministry for several years with Melmore and Republic Trinity. I am grateful that this new appointment did not take me away from St. Paul's or Republic Trinity, and I am leaning forward in great expectation as to what God calls me to do in our collective work with all five churches.

Please pray for Pastor Amy and for myself as we transition into these leadership roles. Please also pray for the people of God's church, as they embark on this new adventure that God has planned for us all!

Greetings from the Missions Committee.

The Missions Committee met after church on April 11. Distribution of the Leeann Wolff funds was reviewed and voted on for the first half of 2021. The following missions will be given \$110 each: FISH, Casa, Sisters in Shelter, Habitat, Patchworks, Tiffin Family Counseling, and St. Paul's Youth Fellowship.

The Easter Offering given in the special Easter envelopes collected \$230 to be sent to Flat Rock. There were also collections for the Sharing Kitchen-\$55 and for the St. Paul's Youth Fund-\$124.65. The total of \$186.75 for Easter flowers purchased by individuals for the altar in honor or memory of loved ones. Thank you, Church, for supporting these missions.

The Third Sunday Ingathering (yellow buckets) \$126.00 was sent to First Call for Help. We frequently do not know who or how this money helps, but at our meeting Pastor Charlene shared an impact story in which First Call was able to help a person having a mental health crisis pay their rent for that month, keeping them in their home, and enabling them to get their life back on track.

There will be special envelopes in the Sunday bulletin on the last Sunday in April. These are for Native American Sunday which is a United Methodist Church mission. Pastor Charlene will present more information on this mission.

Coming up in May we usually collect money for Flood Buckets or Health Kits and send this to the Lakeside Conference. The Conference is going to be virtual so the money will be sent directly to Church World Service (CWS).

Our April meeting included a discussion concerning our October FISH collection of items. It appears that much of this collection is brought back to the Sharing Kitchen. The supply chain for FISH has improved. These are dedicated people providing a very important service and we do not want to add to the workload. In order to make this a meaningful

project we will work with Sharing Kitchen to obtain a targeted list of needed items and post this when we advertise the project.

There were no responses in April indicating readiness to restart Lunch Bunch. We will send out an email again in May.


Thank You!




There are ten youth that have been attending confirmation.
