As we approach the middle of February, we will also begin the season of Lent. Lent is the period of forty days (not counting Sundays) before Easter. It is a time that the church has historically used for repentance, instruction, fasting, and preparation for the celebration of Christ's resurrection on Easter Sunday. Several exciting and important events will be occurring at St. Paul's during the season of Lent that you will want to take note of.

First, Lent begins on February 18th with Ash Wednesday. We will have a joint service with our brothers and sisters at Faith UMC. The service will be at Faith at 7:30pm and will include communion and the receiving of ashes.








Table Favor Committee
