From the Pastor's Pen:

St. Paul's,

During this season of lent a group of us are studying the book of Philippians during a Monday night bible study. In our study this week the following passage comes up from Philippians 2:5-11, "Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited, but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death—even death on a cross.

Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every

knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. "

When I read these verses I am struck by how they seem to so completely sum up the message of the gospel. Jesus came to earth and lived among us, Jesus knows what it means to be Human Jesus died for us, and then was resurrected.

Christ has conquered death and through Christ we might also experience the fullness of life.

During this season of lent, as we prepare ourselves for the celebration of Easter, I encourage you to take some time to reflect on the ways in which the life, death, and resurrection of Christ has transformed your own life. And then I encourage you to share these reflections with others, and join your church family as we celebrate Easter at the end of this month.






