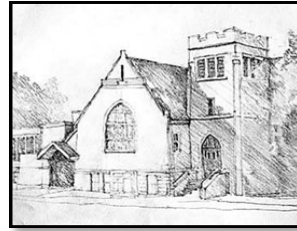

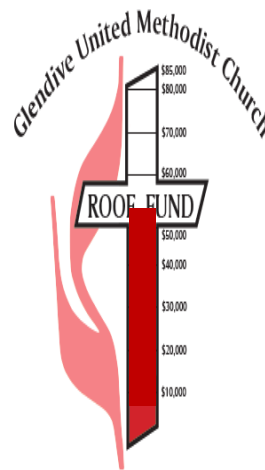

Save your change and remember to bring it to church on Sunday October 1st so we can make some noise and help a local charity help cancer patients.

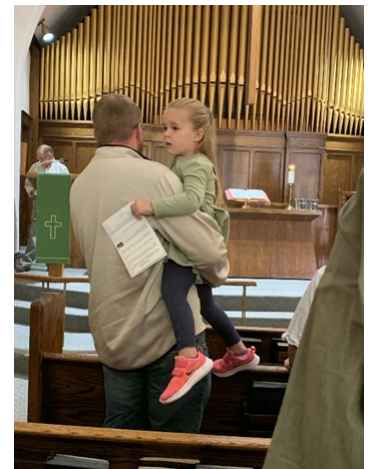
## Rally Day
